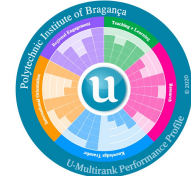

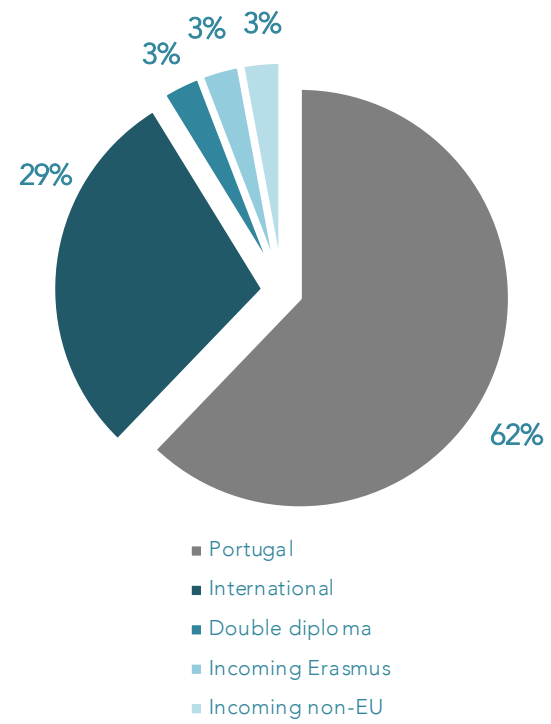


ACADEMIC RANKING OF WORLD UNIVERSITIES
